

## PREMIER LEAGUE

**U17, U18 and U 19 Number of Players:** These age groups are now permitted to have a maximum of 22 players listed on the game roster. However, only 18 players may participate in the game. The coach must identify the 18 players who will participate in the game prior to the start of the game. Those not playing in the game may sit on the team bench but must not be dressed in the uniform that the team is wearing for that game.

**SUBSTITUTION:** The number of substitutions shall be unlimited unless competition under MSYSA jurisdiction determines otherwise. Substitutes may not enter the field of play until receiving a signal to do so from the referee and must do so at the half line. Substitutions may be made by either team at the following times:

1. Prior to a throw-in, with the following exception: IF THE TEAM TAKING THE THROW -IN DOES NOT SUBSTITUTE THEN SUBSTITUTION IS PROHIBITED.
2. PRIOR TO A GOAL KICK
3. AFTER A GOAL IS SCORED
4. AFTER AN INJURY, WHEN THE REFEREE STOPS PLAY
5. AT HALF TIME

AFTER A Caution (a yellow card) the carded player (s) may be substituted, and if

**TEAM BENCHES:** Teams shall take opposite sidelines for their benches. Home teams have a choice of preferred sidelines. Parents and spectators must take the same sidelines as their respective team, unless the facility prevents otherwise. It will be the responsibility of each team's officials (coach, assistant coach or manager) to educate and see that their fans or spectators behave in a proper and respectful manner.

**INSPECTING TEAM ROSTERS & PASS CARDS:** IT IS MANDATORY to check rosters to players and coaches to pass cards and mark game sheets with who is present and who is absent including coaches and team managers! This is to be DONE at each and every game prior to start.

**GAME REPORTS:** Referees should complete game report accurately reporting any send off (red Card) or caution (yellow card), **this includes issuing cards to coaches and team managers with an explanation on the back of report what happened.**

SUBSTITUTIONS: ANY stoppage of play, any player.

U16- up referee	\$40.00	AR's \$30.00 each 45 minute halves

## **MID MICHIGAN YOUTH SOCCER LEAGUE (MMYSL)**

SUBSTITUTIONS: Normal FIFA rules, 1 for 1 on injuries.

Game fees:

U10 center only	\$25.00	25 minute halves
U11/12 Referee	\$21.00	AR's \$18.00 each 30 minute halves
U13/14 Referee	\$30.00	AR's \$20.00 each 35 minute halves
